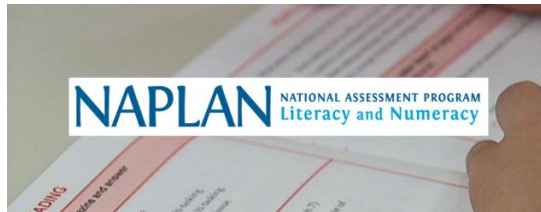

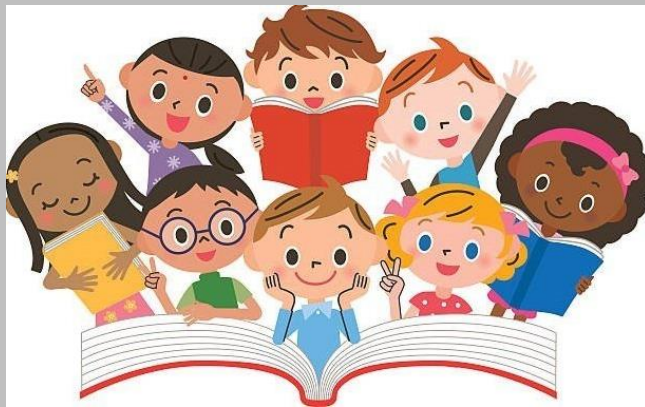


National Simultaneous Story Time

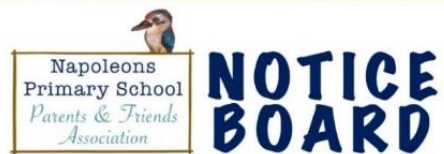
