Enrollments Open for all year levels! Calling all children and their families

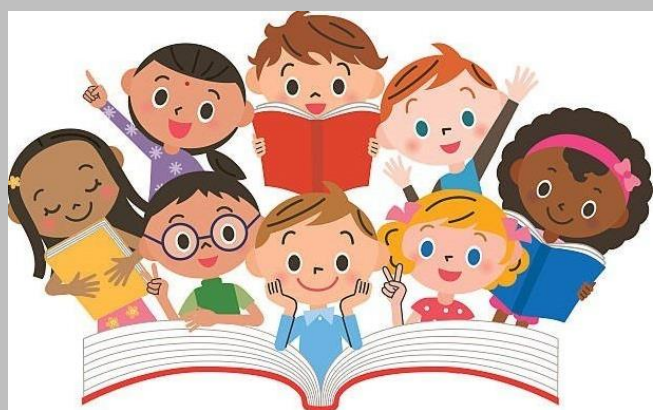
